



## History of Photography Essay Brief

**MINIMUM WORD COUNT:** 1,200-1,800

### Step 1: Do Some Research

Do some online research about the history of photography. Think about how far back you want your essay to cover, and how in-depth you want to write about certain discoveries/timelines.

### Step 2: Make a List of Associated Keywords

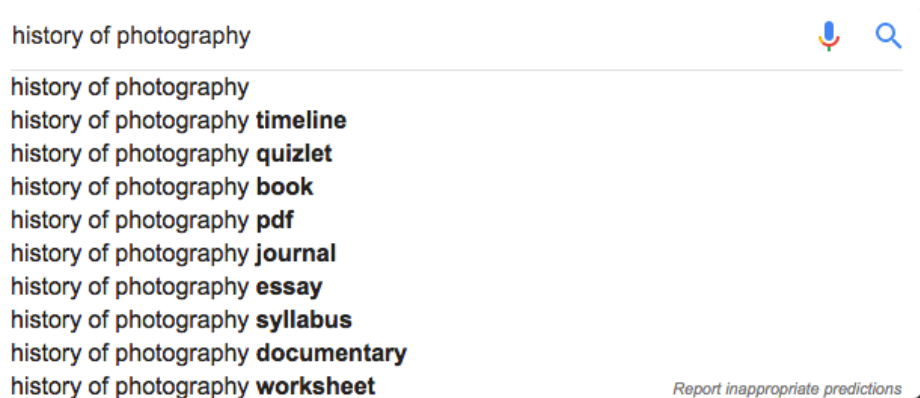
Google a few keywords around the history of photography and the people/places/stories you'll be writing about. Pay special attention to Google's autofill/suggestions.

Make a list and use any keywords that pop up in the autofill suggestions, "People Also Ask" and "Related Searches" sections. This is important because this is what readers will be specifically searching for.

Pay special attention to any questions that pop up and try to answer those questions within your essay. Make sure you cover the basics, like who, when, where, why and how.

Example: When I Google the term "history of photography," one of the keywords to pop up is "History of photography timeline." This tells me that people are interested in seeing the exact years when certain photo discoveries were made.

People also ask questions such as "How was photography discovered?" and "What was the first picture taken?" So you would want to make sure you addressed those questions within your essay as well.

### Step 3: Follow Photonify's Essay Outline Template

Your essay should be written using this template/outline as a guide:

**Introduction** – Write two to three sentences introducing the history of photography.

**Bulleted List** – Create a bulleted list with an overview of what you'll be talking about in the essay. You want to give your reader a quick preview of the information you will be covering so they can quickly scan through to find the information they want to read most. Since this essay is about the history of photography, we recommend making your bulleted list some sort of timeline that lists the date and the event.

**Bulleted List: Expanded** – Refer to the bulleted list you just created. Expand upon each historical event you outlined. Be sure to use subheadings throughout the article so that the text

is broken up a bit and easy to read. A good way to structure your subheadings is by using what you wrote in your bulleted list.

**Conclusion** – Wrap up the article in one or two paragraphs.
